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### Parent Teacher Association – PTA Overview

What is the PTA?

The Parent Teacher Association at Qingdao No. 1 International School of Shandong Province (QISS) is a volunteer organization made up of all parents/guardians and staff at QISS.

Why does the PTA exist?

The PTA at QISS exists in order to provide positive support for educational excellence, while celebrating our cultural diversity and fostering a spirit of community.

What is the purpose of the PTA?

The purpose of the QISS PTA is to:

- 1. Develop a closer connection between school and home by encouraging parent involvement.
- 2. Enhance the educational experience by supporting academic and enrichment activities.
- 3. Improve the environment at our school by providing volunteer and financial support.

Who are the members of the PTA and what do they do?

<u>PTA General Members</u>- All parents/guardians of enrolled students at QISS and staff are automatic members of the PTA. All general members are welcome to attend the quarterly PTA General Assembly meetings.

<u>PTA Executive Board Members</u>-The PTA Executive Board members meet once a month to discuss ongoing planning of social events, discuss issues raised by General PTA members and decide on enrichment requests. The inaugural PTA Executive Board has been selected by appointment and volunteer. Beginning in May of 2014, elections will determine the PTA Executive Board by the PTA General Members.

### What is an Enrichment Request?

Teachers, staff and parents can apply to get a project/activity/item sponsored by the PTA by completing an Enrichment Request. The application form, guidelines for applying, and the request procedure are determined and reviewed by the PTA Executive Board.

The PTA seeks to support as many worthwhile activities it can reasonably support with its funds. This is consistent with the PTA's existence: To provide positive support towards educational excellence, while celebrating our cultural diversity and fostering a spirit of community.

### What will the PTA use donated funds for?

The funds raised throughout the year by the PTA are used for the following:

- 1. Enrichment Requests for student enrichment in the classroom.
- 2. Planning and Funding of PTA Social Events such as the Welcome Social, PTA Gala & Silent Auction, Teacher Appreciation among other events.
- 3. Purchase refreshments needed to supply the refreshment stand at QISS events.

### Volunteer Information:

As a way to further enrich your child's education, please consider volunteering with the QISS PTA. There are many opportunities throughout the year to volunteer, some requiring more time than others. You may volunteer on a regular basis or just occasionally as your schedule permits.

Below you will find descriptions of various activities that need volunteer support of the PTA. There are many ways of assisting and I hope that you find something that interests you. This is a great way to meet parents, teachers and staff of QISS, while creating a positive and welcoming atmosphere at QISS.

#### Committees:

International Day: QISS PTA is looking for parent volunteers who would like to assist QISS teachers in executing our lively day of celebrating our cultures. PTA will be responsible for organizing the International Food Court in the Lower School cafeteria. International Day is approaching quickly and will take place on Saturday, 14 September 2013 at QISS.

Halloween: Parent volunteers are needed to assist QISS teachers in Halloween activities.

Décor Committee: Volunteers are needed to help deck out QISS to make the school a festive environment for various holidays. The Décor Committee is strictly responsible for decorating the school during various times of the year to be determined by the committee.

Refreshment Committee: Volunteers for the refreshment committee are responsible for purchasing (with approved PTA funds) or obtaining donated refreshments and selling these refreshments at various QISS school events.

Spirit Wear Committee: The Spirit Wear committee is responsible for designing, collecting orders, and ordering of QISS Spirit Wear. All QISS logo items must be approved by QISS before being publically announced for purchase.

PTA Gala & Silent Auction Committee: Volunteers of this committee will be responsible for organizing and obtaining items for the silent auction.

Teacher Appreciation Committee: This committee is responsible for determining how the PTA wants to honor the teachers and staff of QISS for their efforts throughout the year.

White Elephant Committee: Volunteers of this committee are responsible for working with QISS to organize and hold our first annual White Elephant Sale to benefit families of QISS and the QISS PTA.

### In the Classroom:

*Room Parent:* It would be ideal for each grade level to have a parent volunteer to help in communications between the teacher and parents. Responsibilities of a Room Parent are:

- 1. Maintain the class contact list,
- 2. "reach out" to incoming students and their families,
- 3. Promote parental awareness of upcoming class events,
- 4. Possibly plan class events outside of school occasionally throughout the year (for example: laser tag, bowling, etc.).
